Terms and conditions (*Please retain this information*)

The following terms and conditions, which will constitute part of the Acceptance Form to be signed at the time of entry and form part of the agreement between the School and parent/guardian, may be amended from time to time by the School and, with any such amendments, shall continue to apply so long as the boy/girl continues to be a pupil of the School irrespective of his/her age.

1. Regular and punctual attendance is required. No pupil may be absent, except for illness, without leave previously obtained from the relevant Head of School/Head of the Prep, on a written request from the parent or guardian, and in every case the reason shall be stated. Leave will not be granted except in cases of emergency.
2. Day pupils are expected to reside with a parent or legal guardian, and are accepted on the understanding that they will continue to reside within acceptably close daily travelling of the School of which the Principal shall be the sole judge. Any exception to this rule needs the signed permission of the Principal. Parents of boarders must appoint suitable guardians if their normal residence is abroad.
3. Fees in respect of the first School term attended are due on the date of acceptance by parent or guardian for a place for his/her son, daughter or ward, although payment of such fees is not required until an invoice is issued by the School. A term time credit facility is available, details of which can be obtained from the School's Finance Department (01442 358008). A deposit, currently £1000, is payable on Acceptance for all pupils other than Stepping Stones half day pupils, for whom a deposit of £500 is payable. One half of the deposit of £1000 will be credited to your son's/daughter's account at the beginning of the first term in the School; the remaining £500 (the full deposit in the case of Stepping Stones half day pupils) will be credited to your son's/daughter's final account on his/her leaving the School, less any outstanding amounts due to the School. If the deposit of £1000/£500 is paid and the pupil does not subsequently join the School, no refund will normally be made.
4. Fees in respect of subsequent terms and extras for the previous term are due by the first day of each term. The agreement for education of a boy/girl at the School may be terminated either by giving a full term's notice to the relevant Head of School/Head of the Prep, or subject to a payment of an amount equal to a full term's fees on giving notice at any time before the first day of the next following term.
5. No remission of fees is given by the School for absence for any reason, including ill health, study leave, temporary or permanent exclusion.
